In light of significant uncertainty surrounding the Fall 2020 term in light of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the SSU Board is committed to adjusting our fees to accurately reflect our operational costs surrounding our transition to virtual support and engagement, and to find value for our students in a time of considerable fiscal uncertainty. As a result, the SSU Board authorizes the following fee adjustments for the Fall 2020 term:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the SSU Board DISCONTINUE the essential collection of:

- A) the SSU Health & Counselling Fee
- B) SSU Academic Support Fee
- C) SSU Campus Safety Fee
- D) SSU Building Operating Fee, and;

DISCONTINUE the non-essential collection of the:

- E) SSU Student Life Fee, and
- F) SSU Clubs Fee;

AND THAT FURTHER, the SSU Board authorizes the collection of:

- 1) an ESSENTIAL SSU Student Experience Fee of \$70.00 for the 2020 Fall Term, and
- 2) a NON-ESSENTIAL collection of a SSU Food Bank Fee of \$5.00 for the 2020 Fall Term,

AND THAT FURTHER, that

- 3) the ESSENTIAL SSU Building Fee be reduced to \$35.00 for the 2020 Fall Term
- 4) the ESSENTIAL SSU Capital Fee remain \$10.00 for the 2020 Fall Term
- 5) that the ESSENTIAL (WITH OPT OUT) SSU Health and Dental Fee be \$295/annual for the 2020 Fall Term
- 6) that the NON-ESSENTIAL Sheridan Life Radio Fee remain \$5.00 for the Fall Term, and that.
- 7) the NON-ESSENTIAL Student Refugee Program Fee (collected and administered by Sheridan College) remain at \$1.50 for the 2020 Fall Term.
